The award will be made to the most outstanding project, judged on design quality, value for money, fit for purpose and client satisfaction. Schemes can be in any building sector as long as they are occupied and were completed in 2008 / 2009. There is no limit to the number of schemes you can enter.

### Each entry will require:

- Completed entry form
- One page summary of the project
- One page description of the project in use
- Statement of support from the client/end-user, about their experience of using the completed building
- Selection of key drawings, location plans, site plan, floor plan, sections
- List of key consultants
- Between six and ten colour prints
- Disc of images as jpegs (minimum 300dpi) supplied on disc
- Written permission of the photographer(s), indicating that images may be used in the promotion of your project for this award
- Entry cheque of £30 + VAT (£35.35) made payable to RIBA North West
